On March 13<sup>th</sup> you will be voting on a warrant article pertaining to the purchase of a new **Wheelchair Van** for the Police Department's Senior Citizen Program. This van will cost \$46,000.00 of which I have raised \$22,210.00 in donations, leaving a balance of \$23,790.00. This van will be purchased on a four (4) year lease agreement with **this years cost being \$5,947.00.**

Our present van is on its way out. We can no longer afford the repair costs. It has over 169,000 miles on its odometer and was purchased second hand with funds from our donation account. We are still receiving donations towards this van and all funds received during the year will be applied to the total cost of the Wheelchair Van.

Our seniors deserve the best possible service we can provide them. The Police Department provides between three (3) to five (5) transports a day. The **Wheelchair Van** plays an intricate part of our senior citizen program, with a lot of wheelchair bound seniors finding that without our services they would not be able to attend doctor's visits or even go to see a friend.

On behalf of the seniors in town and the members of the Atkinson Police Department's Senior Citizen Division, I respectfully request that you vote for the purchase of our much needed **Wheelchair Van.**
